

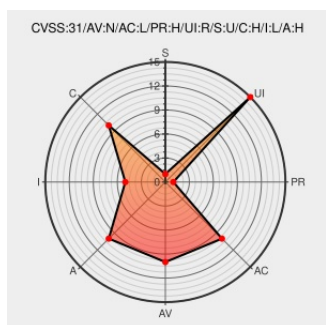

Certain versions of [Groupware](#) from [Handysoft](#) contain the following vulnerability:

ActiveX Control(HShell.dll) in Handy Groupware 1.7.3.1 for Windows 7, 8, and 10 allows an attacker to execute arbitrary command via the ShellExec method.

CVE-2020-7804 has been assigned by [KISA](#) vuln@krcert.or.kr to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
