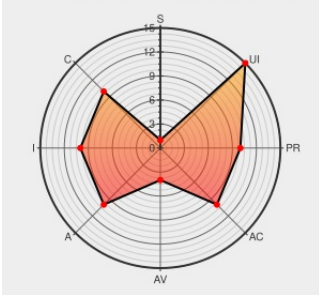

Certain versions of [Voiceye Wsactivebridges](#) from [Voiceye Wsactivebridgees Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

VOICEYE WActiveBridgeES versions prior to 2.1.0.3 contains a stack-based buffer overflow vulnerability caused by improper bound checking parameter given by attack. It finally leads to a stack-based buffer overflow via access to crafted web page.

CVE-2020-7836 has been assigned by [KISA](#) vuln@krcert.or.kr to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
