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Certain versions of [Nbbdownloader.ocx](#) from [Douzone](#) contain the following vulnerability:

NBBDowndownloader.ocx ActiveX Control in Groupware contains a vulnerability that could allow remote files to be downloaded and executed by setting the arguments to the activex method. A remote attacker could induce a user to access a crafted web page, causing damage such as malicious code infection.

CVE-2020-7850 has been assigned by [KISA](#) vuln@krcert.or.kr to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
