

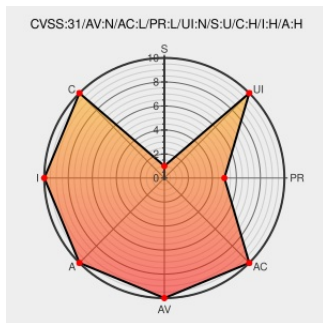

Certain versions of [Plone](#) from [Plone](#) contain the following vulnerability:
SQL Injection in DTML or in connection objects in Plone 4.0 through 5.2.1 allows users to perform unwanted SQL queries. (This is a problem in Zope.)

CVE-2020-7939 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
