

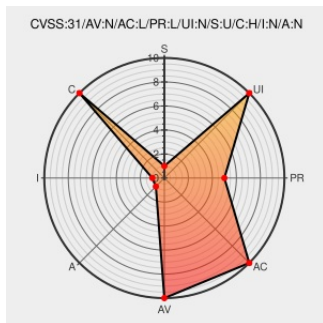

Certain versions of [Fedora](#) from [Fedoraproject](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A missing access control check in Nextcloud Server < 18.0.1, < 17.0.4, and < 16.0.9 causes hide-download shares to be downloadable when appending /download to the URL.

CVE-2020-8139 has been assigned by [h1](#) support@hackerone.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
