

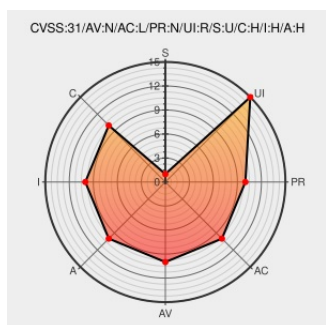

Certain versions of [Cups Easy](#) from [Cups Easy Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cups Easy (Purchase & Inventory) 1.0 is vulnerable to CSRF that leads to admin account takeover via passwordmychange.php.

CVE-2020-8424 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
