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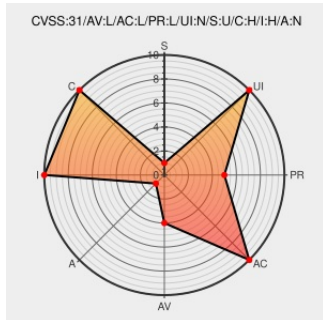

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Certain versions of [Pactware](#) from [Pactware](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In PACTware before 4.1 SP6 and 5.x before 5.0.5.31, passwords are stored in an insecure manner, and may be modified by an attacker with no knowledge of the current passwords.

CVE-2020-9404 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
