

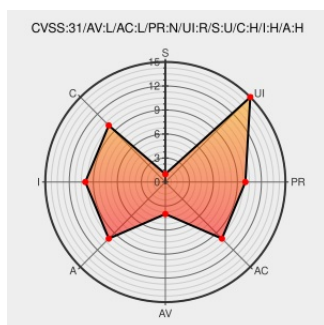

Certain versions of [Windows](#) from [Microsoft](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An untrusted search path vulnerability in the installer of PDFescape Desktop version 4.0.22 and earlier allows an attacker to gain privileges and execute code via DLL hijacking.

CVE-2020-9418 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
