Certain versions of [Bridge](#) from [Adobe](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Adobe Bridge versions 10.0.1 and earlier version have a stack-based buffer overflow vulnerability. Successful exploitation could lead to arbitrary code execution.

CVE-2020-9555 has been assigned by psirt@adobe.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
