

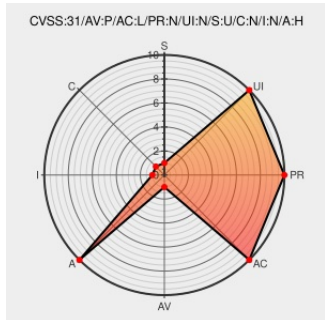

Certain versions of [Ipados](#) from [Apple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A validation issue was addressed with improved input sanitization. This issue is fixed in iOS 13.5 and iPadOS 13.5, macOS Catalina 10.15.5. A USB device may be able to cause a denial of service.

CVE-2020-9792 has been assigned by product-security@apple.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
