Description	Multiple vulnerabilities in the web UI of Cisco Smart Software Manager Satellite could allow an unauthenticated, remote attacker to execute arbitrary code on the target system. The vulnerability is due to a buffer overflow in the web UI. An attacker can exploit this by sending a specially crafted request to the web UI. The attacker can then execute arbitrary code on the target system. This vulnerability affects Cisco Smart Software Manager Satellite versions 2.1.0 through 2.1.1. Cisco has released a patch for this vulnerability in version 2.1.2. Users are advised to upgrade to the latest version of the software.
