

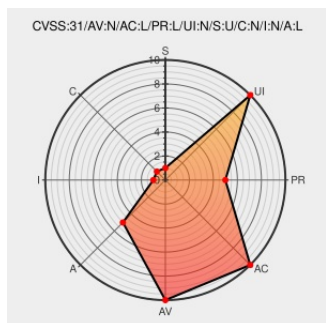

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CVE-2021-1266 - advisory for cisco-sa-msx-dos-4j7sytvU

Certain versions of [Managed Services Accelerator](#) from [Cisco](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability in the REST API of Cisco Managed Services Accelerator (MSX) could allow an authenticated, remote attacker to cause a denial of service (DoS) condition on an affected device. The vulnerability is due to the way that the affected software logs certain API requests. An attacker could exploit this vulnerability by sending a flood of crafted API

requests to an affected device. A successful exploit could allow the attacker to cause a DoS condition on the affected device.

CVE-2021-1266 has been assigned by [Cisco](#) psirt@cisco.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

The Cisco Product Security Incident Response Team (PSIRT) is not aware of any public announcements or malicious use of the vulnerability that is described in this advisory.
