

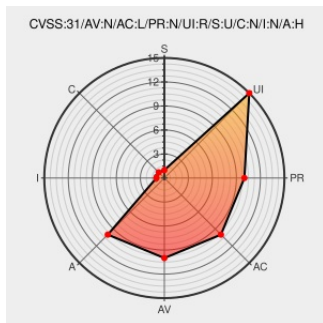

Certain versions of [Macos](#) from [Apple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A logic issue was addressed with improved state management. This issue is fixed in watchOS 7.6, macOS Big Sur 11.5. Visiting a maliciously crafted webpage may lead to a system denial of service.

CVE-2021-1821 has been assigned by product-security@apple.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
