

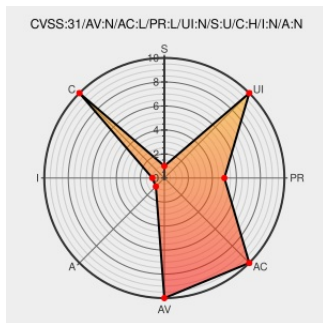

Certain versions of [Maximo For Civil Infrastructure](#) from [Ibm](#) contain the following vulnerability:

IBM Maximo for Civil Infrastructure 7.6.2 could allow a user to obtain sensitive information due to insecure storage of authentication credentials. IBM X-Force ID: 196621.
