

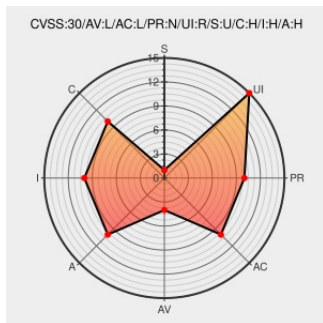

Certain versions of [Bridge](#) from [Adobe](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Adobe Bridge versions 10.1.1 (and earlier) and 11.0.1 (and earlier) are affected by an Out-of-bounds write vulnerability when parsing a crafted file. An unauthenticated attacker could leverage this vulnerability to achieve arbitrary code execution in the context of the current user.

Exploitation of this issue requires user interaction in that a victim must open a malicious file.

CVE-2021-21095 has been assigned by psirt@adobe.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
