

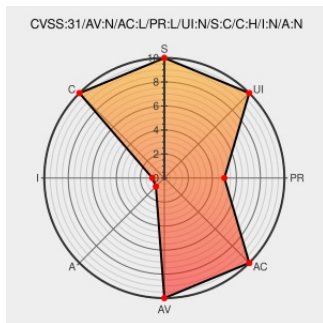

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CVE-2021-21269 - advisory for GHSA-pg25-xfcf-vjvm

Certain versions of [Keymaker](#) from [Keymaker Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Keymaker is a Mastodon Community Finder based Matrix Community serverlist page Server. In Keymaker before version 0.2.0, the assets endpoint did not check for the extension. The rust `join` method without checking user input might have made it able to do a Path Traversal attack causing to read more files than allowed. This is fixed in version

0.2.0.

CVE-2021-21269 has been assigned by security-advisories@github.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **keymaker-mx** - **keymaker** version < 0.2.0
