

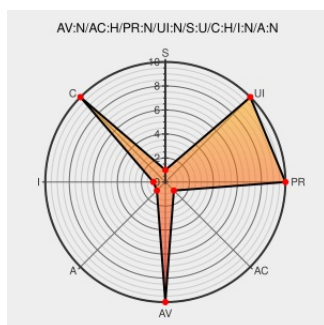

Certain versions of [Gitlab](#) from [Gitlab](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue has been discovered in GitLab CE/EE affecting all versions starting with 12.6. Under a special condition it was possible to access data of an internal repository through a public project fork as an anonymous user.

CVE-2021-22200 has been assigned by cve@gitlab.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
