

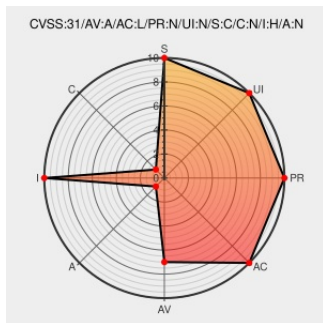

There is an Improper Access Control vulnerability in Huawei Smartphone. Successful exploitation of this vulnerability may cause app redirections.
