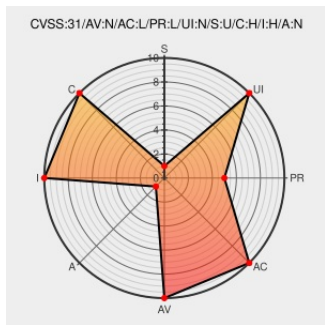

Certain versions of **lsetup** from **Oracle** contain the following vulnerability:

Vulnerability in the Oracle iSetup product of Oracle E-Business Suite (component: General Ledger Update Transform, Reports). Supported versions that are affected are 12.1.3 and 12.2.3-12.2.10. Easily exploitable vulnerability allows low privileged attacker with network access via HTTP to compromise Oracle iSetup. Successful attacks of

this vulnerability can result in unauthorized creation, deletion or modification access to critical data or all Oracle iSetup accessible data as well as unauthorized access to critical data or complete access to all Oracle iSetup accessible data. CVSS 3.1 Base Score 8.1 (Confidentiality and Integrity impacts). CVSS Vector: (CVSS:3.1/AV:N/AC:L/PR:L/UI:N/S:U/C:H/I:H/A:N).
