Certain versions of [Big-ip Access Policy Manager](#) from [F5](#) contain the following vulnerability:

On version 16.0.x before 16.0.1.2, 15.1.x before 15.1.3, 14.1.x before 14.1.2.8, and all versions of 13.1.x and 12.1.x, when IPSec is configured on a BIG-IP system, undisclosed requests from an authorized remote (IPSec) peer, which already has a negotiated Security Association, can cause the Traffic Management Microkernel

(TMM) to terminate. Note: Software versions which have reached End of Technical Support (EoTS) are not evaluated.

CVE-2021-23039 has been assigned by f5sirt@f5.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
