

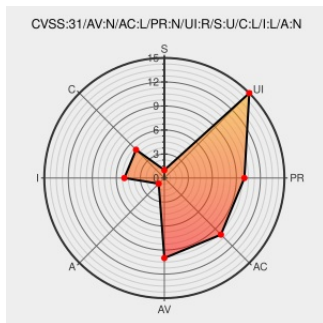

The package karma before 6.3.16 are vulnerable to Open Redirect due to missing validation of the return_url query parameter.
