

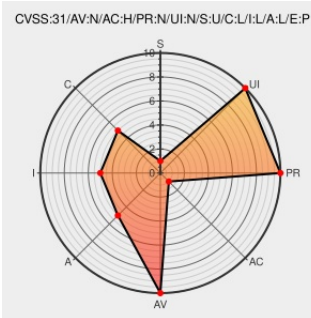

Certain versions of [Keyget](#) from [Keyget Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The package keyget from 0.0.0 are vulnerable to Prototype Pollution via the methods set, push, and at which could allow an attacker to cause a denial of service and may lead to remote code execution.
****Note:**** This vulnerability derives from an incomplete fix to [CVE-2020-28272](https://security.snyk.io/vuln/SNYK-JS-KEYGET-1048048)

CVE-2021-23760 has been assigned by report@snyk.io to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
