Certain versions of [Cashtomer](#) from [Cashtomer Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An editid GET parameter of the Cashtomer WordPress plugin through 1.0.0 is not properly sanitised, escaped or validated before inserting to a SQL statement, leading to SQL injection.

CVE-2021-24391 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
