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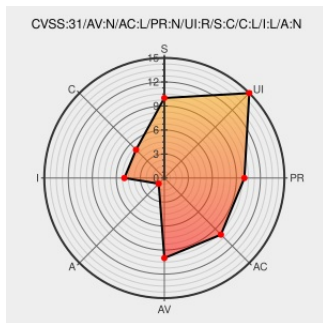

Certain versions of [Custom Login Redirect](#) from [Custom Login Redirect Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Custom Login Redirect WordPress plugin through 1.0.0 does not have CSRF check in place when saving its settings, and do not sanitise or escape user input before outputting them back in the page, leading to a Stored Cross-Site Scripting issue

CVE-2021-24536 has been assigned by [contact@wpscan.com](mailto:contact@wpscan.com) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Unknown - Custom Login Redirect** version <= 1.0.0
