Certain versions of [jQuery-reply-to-comment](#) from [jQuery-reply-to-comment Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The jQuery Reply to Comment WordPress plugin through 1.31 does not have any CSRF check when saving its settings, nor sanitise or escape its 'Quote String' and 'Reply String' settings before outputting them in Comments, leading to a Stored Cross-Site Scripting issue.

CVE-2021-24543 has been assigned by [contact@wpscan.com](mailto:contact@wpscan.com) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Unknown - jQuery Reply to Comment** version <= 1.31
