

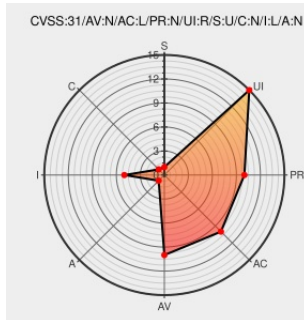

Certain versions of [Single Post Exporter](#) from [Single Post Exporter Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Single Post Exporter WordPress plugin through 1.1.1 does not have CSRF checks when saving its settings, which could allow attackers to make a logged in admin change them via a CSRF attack and give access to the export feature to any role such as subscriber.

Subscriber users would then be able to export an arbitrary post/page (such as private and password protected) via a direct URL

CVE-2021-24780 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Unknown - Single Post Exporter** version <= 1.1.1
