

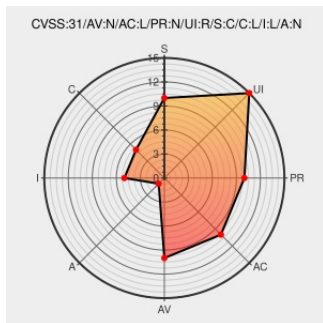

Certain versions of [Anycomment](#) from [Bologer](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The AnyComment WordPress plugin before 0.3.5 has an API endpoint which passes user input via the redirect parameter to the wp_redirect() function without being validated first, leading to an Open Redirect issue, which according to the vendor, is a feature.

CVE-2021-24838 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Unknown** - **AnyComment** version < 0.3.5
