

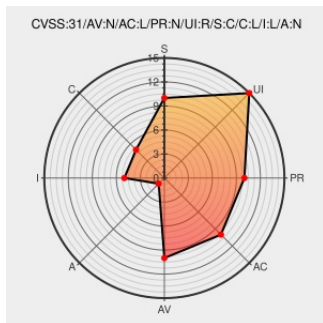

Certain versions of [Booster For Woocommerce](#) from [Booster](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Booster for WooCommerce WordPress plugin before 5.4.9 does not sanitise and escape the wcj_notice parameter before outputting it back in the admin dashboard when the Pdf Invoicing module is enabled, leading to a Reflected Cross-Site Scripting

CVE-2021-24999 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Unknown - Booster for WooCommerce** version < 5.4.9
