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Certain versions of [Whmcs Bridge](#) from [I-plugins](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The WHMCS Bridge WordPress plugin before 6.4b does not sanitise and escape the error parameter before outputting it back in admin dashboard, leading to a Reflected Cross-Site Scripting

CVE-2021-25112 has been assigned by contact@wpscan.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
