

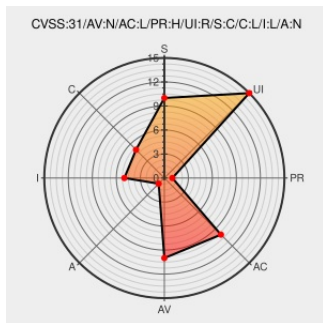

Certain versions of [Ftapi](#) from [Ftapi](#) contain the following vulnerability:

FTAPI 4.0 through 4.10 allows XSS via an SVG document to the Background Image upload feature in the Submit Box Template Editor.

CVE-2021-25278 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
