

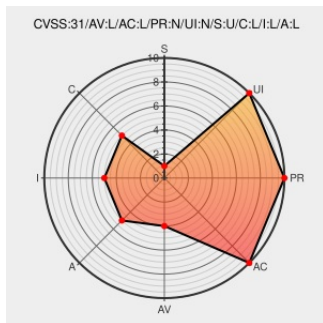

Certain versions of [Samsung Flow](#) from [Samsung](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A missing input validation in Samsung Flow Windows application prior to Version 4.8.5.0 allows attackers to overwrite abraty file in the Windows known folders.

CVE-2021-25509 has been assigned by [S](#) mobile.security@samsung.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
