

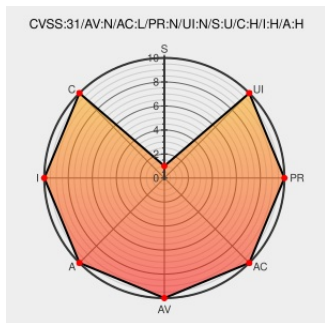

Certain versions of [Js-extend](#) from [Js-extend Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Prototype pollution vulnerability in 'js-extend' versions 0.0.1 through 1.0.1 allows attacker to cause a denial of service and may lead to remote code execution.

CVE-2021-25945 has been assigned by [vulnerabilitylab@whitesourcesoftware.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
