

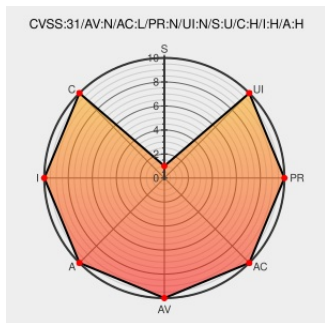

Certain versions of [Eprints](#) from [Eprints](#) contain the following vulnerability:

EPrints 3.4.2 allows remote attackers to execute OS commands via crafted LaTeX input to a `cgi/cal?year=` URI.

CVE-2021-26476 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
