

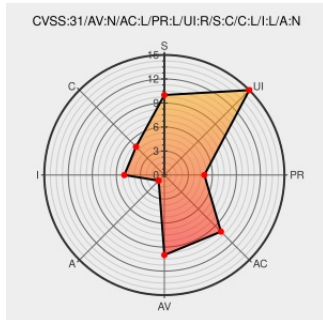

Certain versions of [Batflat](#) from [Batflat](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in Snippets in Batflat CMS 1.3.6 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the field name.

CVE-2021-27678 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

CVSS3 Score: **5.4 - MEDIUM**
