

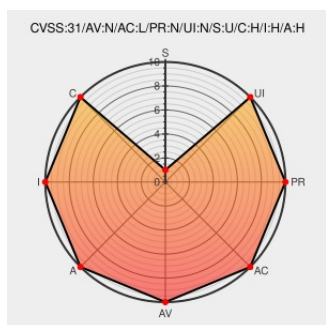

Certain versions of [Vhs](#) from [Vhs Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The vhs (aka VHS: Fluid ViewHelpers) extension before 5.1.1 for TYPO3 allows SQL injection via isLanguageViewHelper.

CVE-2021-28381 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
