Description	A Server-Side Request Forgery (SSRF) vulnerability in ArcGIS Server Manager version 10.8.1 and below may allow a remote attacker to exploit a buffer overflow in the ArcGIS Server Manager web application, which could lead to a denial of service (DoS) condition. The vulnerability is due to the ArcGIS Server Manager web application not properly validating the length of the request body. An attacker can exploit this vulnerability by sending a request with a large body to the ArcGIS Server Manager web application, which could cause the application to crash. The vulnerability is present in ArcGIS Server Manager version 10.8.1 and below. Users are advised to upgrade to version 10.8.2 or later to resolve this vulnerability.
