

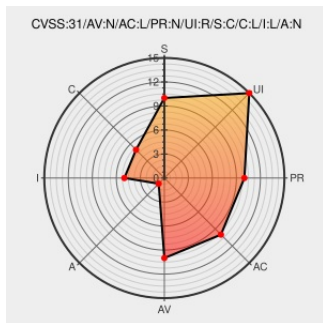

Cross Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability exists in SeaCMS 12.6 via the (1) v_company and (2) v_tvs parameters in /admin_video.php,
