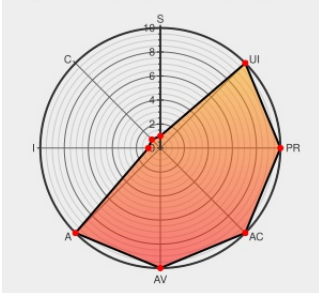

Certain versions of [Slice-deque](#) from [Slice-deque Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in the slice-deque crate through 2021-02-19 for Rust. A double drop can occur in SliceDeque::drain_filter upon a panic in a predicate function.

CVE-2021-29938 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
