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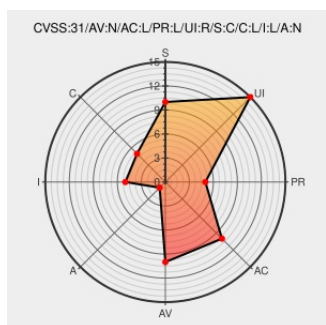

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Certain versions of [Custom Global Variables](#) from [Custom Global Variables Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Stored cross-site scripting (XSS) in form field in robust.systems product Custom Global Variables v 1.0.5 allows a remote attacker to inject arbitrary code via the vars[0][name] field.

CVE-2021-3124 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
