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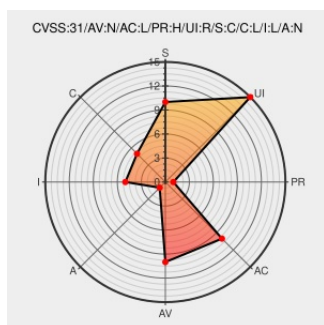

Cross Site Scripting (XSS) vulnerability in neofarg-cms 0.2.3 allows remote attacker to run arbitrary code via the copyright field in copyright settings.
