Certain versions of [Safeq](#) from [Ysoft](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Incorrect privileges in the MU55 FlexiSpooler service in YSoft SafeQ 6 6.0.55 allows local user privilege escalation by overwriting the executable file via an alternative data stream.

CVE-2021-31859 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
