

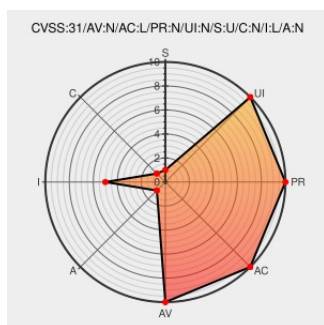

Certain versions of [S3scanner](#) from [S3scanner Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

S3Scanner before 2.0.2 allows Directory Traversal via a crafted bucket, as demonstrated by a `<Key>../` substring in a `ListBucketResult` element.

CVE-2021-32061 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
