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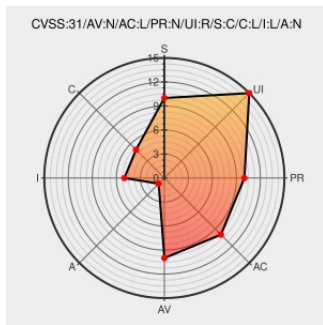

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Certain versions of [Cs-cart](#) from [Cs-cart](#) contain the following vulnerability:

In CS-Cart version 4.11.1, it is possible to induce copy-paste XSS by manipulating the "post description" filed in the blog post creation page.

CVE-2021-32202 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
