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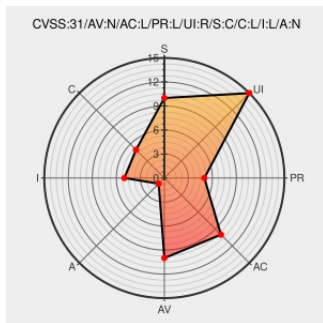

Certain versions of Moodle from Moodle contain the following vulnerability:

ID numbers displayed in the quiz grading report required additional sanitizing to prevent a stored XSS risk. Moodle 3.10 to 3.10.3, 3.9 to 3.9.6, 3.8 to 3.8.8, 3.5 to 3.5.17 and earlier unsupported versions are affected.

CVE-2021-32475 has been assigned by secalert@redhat.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
