

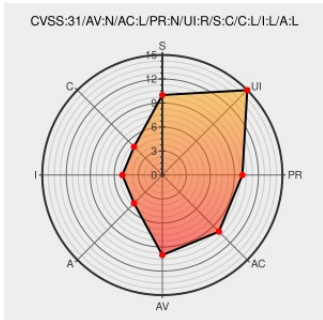

An attacker may be able to inject client-side JavaScript code on multiple instances within all versions of Uffizio GPS Tracker.
