

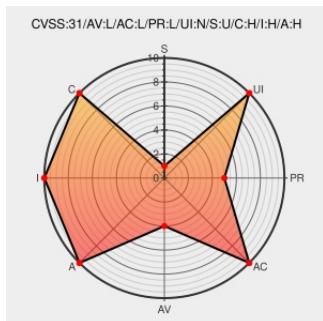

Certain versions of [Kernelflinger](#) from [Intel](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Out-of-bounds write in the Intel(R) Kernelflinger project may allow an authenticated user to potentially enable escalation of privilege via local access.

CVE-2021-33137 has been assigned by [intel](#) secure@intel.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
