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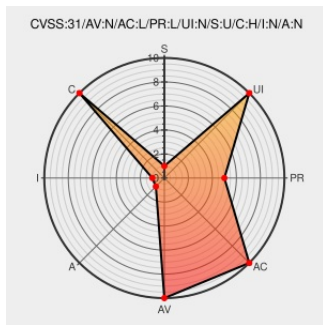

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Certain versions of [Http Commander](#) from [Element-it](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An SSRF vulnerability in the "Upload from URL" feature in Elements-IT HTTP Commander 5.3.3 allows remote authenticated users to retrieve HTTP and FTP files from the internal server network by inserting an internal address.

CVE-2021-33213 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
