

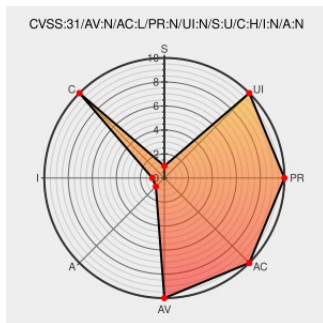

Cartadis Gespape through 8.2.1 allows Directory Traversal in `gespape/doDownloadData` and `gespape/webapp/doDownloadData`.

CVE-2021-33807 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
