Certain versions of [Spotweb](#) from [Spotweb Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in spotweb 1.4.9, allows authenticated attackers to execute arbitrary code via crafted GET request to the login page.

CVE-2021-33966 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
