

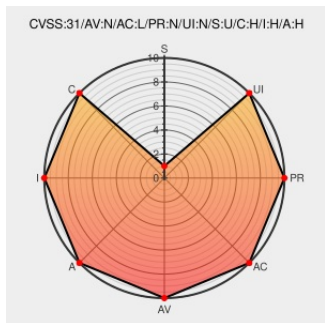

Certain versions of [Docker-tester](#) from [Docker-tester Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

OS Command injection vulnerability in Mintzo Docker-Tester through 1.2.1 allows attackers to execute arbitrary commands via shell metacharacters in the 'ports' entry of a crafted docker-compose.yml file.

CVE-2021-34079 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
